K-2 reading winter assessment data that was shared with ASD. 4 schools on target (Bayshore, Birchwood ABC, Eagle Academy, and Northern Lights ABC) with Winter 22-23 including Birchwood with the highest growth rate (12%) of the 4 on target schools. 2 other elementary schools were near target (Bear Valley and Chugiak) and the rest were below target.
